



- High sucrose and ts/ha
- Capable of cane yield above 100 tc/ha
- Clay loam and well-drained clay soils
- To be grown in Wet West only
- Semi-erect
- Medium to thick yellowish-green stalks
- Round bud set in cream colour root band
- Broad medium-length leaves
- Early canopy
- Early, middle and late season reaping
- Lodge at high tonnage
- Free-trashing
- Above-average sucrose and ts/ha
- · Very high yield above 100 tc/ha
- Grows well on light, medium, and heavy soils in rain-fed areas
- Very tall and erect cane
- Thin to medium stalks
- Wine-red (young) to purplish (older) stalks
- · Ovate bud just touching growth ring in yellow-brown root band
- Narrow, medium-length leaves
- Early canopy closur
- Early, middle, and late season reaping
- Will lodge at high tonnages
- Free-trashing
- Tolerant to Smut, Orange Rust, and Cane Fly

Fertilize, irrigate, control pests, harvest and mill responsibly.
